

THE STATE OF PSYCHOLOGICAL STAFF TRAINING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ANOTHER STATE

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Abstract

In this article, the situation of personnel training in the field of psychology in Uzbekistan is revealed on the example of the Department of Psychology of Karshi State University.

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Today, the issue of training sufficiently qualified personnel in the field in the development and introduction of effective forms and methods of psychological services based on the prospects of renewal, social and economic development, society's needs, modern achievements of science, culture, technique and technology is gaining urgent importance.

According to the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on February 28, 1992 "On the establishment of new higher educational institutions of the Republic", Karshi State Pedagogical Institute was also granted the status of a university [1].

The work of training psychologists has also been started at Karshi State University. The Department of Psychology plays a special role in this. In the 2015/16 academic year, 22 professors (1 doctor of science, professor, 1 candidate of science, associate professor, 3 candidates of science, senior teacher, 4 senior teachers, and 13 teachers) worked in the department [2].

The Department of Psychology was separated from the Department of Pedagogy and Psychology in 1985. Department of Psychology was ruled between 1985 and 1990 years by associate professor G. Mazetova, from 1991 to 1993 by Assoc. A. Jabborov, between 1994 and 1998 by Assoc. N. Boymurodov, from 1999 to 2015 by professor Azim Jabbarov, from 2015 to 2018 by associate professor Kh. Karimov, from 2018 to 2021 by Assoc. M. Fayzieva, from April 2022 until now by Assoc. B. Joraev [3].

General education schools, secondary special and vocational educational institutions in the region are provided with psychologists in this specialty.

In the Department of Psychology, since the 1993-1994 academic year, "5310200 - Psychology in the field of education", since 2015 "5210200 - Psychology: in the direction of activities", since 2018 "5210203 - Applied psychology" are preparing bachelors to receive a diploma of higher education and basic specialization.

In the department, there is an increasing demand for psychologists in the social development of the region, as well as training of psychologists in the part-time and second higher education direction, as provided by general education schools, secondary special and vocational education institutions in the

region [4].

Also, masters are studying at the department in the directions "70310901 - Psychology (by types of activity) and Psychology of family relations". "19.00.05 - Social psychology. " Ethnopsychology" specialization training of basic doctoral students has been launched [5].

Specialists being trained at the department of psychology work as psychologists in general education schools of Kashkadarya region, inspector-psychologists for working with minors in the Internal Affairs system, regional administration, scientific research institutes of the region "Supporting the Family and Neighborhood" and many other organizations.

In the 2021-2022 academic years, 29 professors worked in the Department of Psychology. 1 of them is doctor of science, professor; 4 candidates of science are associate professors; 4 Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) associate professors in psychology, 2 senior teachers; There are 18 teachers [6].

In addition to general professional subjects, in-depth specialized subjects are also taught at the department. Including General psychology, Ethnopsychology and psychology of religion, Experimental psychology and practicum, History of psychology, Psychological phenomena and methodology, Sports psychology, Counseling psychology and psychocorrection, General psychodiagnostics, Social psychology, Developmental and differential psychology, Pedagogical psychology and psychology teaching methodology, Medical psychology and psychotherapy, Labor and engineering psychology, Basics of social psychological training, Basics of psychological service, Legal psychology, Spiritual psychology, Family psychology, Individual and group consultation, Psychology of children with deviant behavior and other subjects are being taught. The Department of Psychology of the Faculty of Pedagogy conducts scientific research in the direction of "Social-psychological features of improving educational processes taking into account national and regional characteristics". A number of monographs and pamphlets have been published in this direction. Among the members of the department, E.Yoziev and B.Joraev defended their doctoral theses [8].

In the next 5 years, 4 Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) theses were prepared at the department and all of them were successfully defended (B. Jo'raev, G. Sattorova, Z. Fayziev, Sh. Bekova). 3 faculty members from the department (M. Fayzieva and B. Jo'raev, Z. Fayziev) are preparing PhD theses as independent researchers [9].

In addition, professors-teachers of the department are conducting scientific research on a large scale. In particular, in the following years, about 100 scientific articles were published by the members of the department in Scopus, prestigious foreign journals and scientific journals on the list of OAK. Including Professor A. Jabborov, associate professor M. Fayzieva, associate professor M. Maksadova, associate professor H. Karimov, associate professor L. Beknazorova, associate professor B. Jo'raev, associate professor. v/b. Z. Fayziev, doctor of philosophy (PhD), senior teacher Sh. Bekova, teacher F. Rajabova, Sh. Adilova, I. Jabborov, S. Kulatova, J. Amirkulov and others can be cited as an example of scientific research work [10]

In the department, professor A. Jabborov's monographs "Psychodiagnostics and psychocorrection of the formation of criminal motives in teenagers", assistant professor M. Fayzieva's monographs "Protective mechanisms of personal psychology", E. Yoziev's study guide "Management psychology", Z. Fayziev's "Management of emotional states in sports activities" socio-psychological mechanisms", G. Sattorova's "Psychologist of emotion and will" and "Psychocorrection of volitional qualities", Kh. Karimov's "Sports psychology" educational and educational manuals were published this year [11].

He works with talented students in the "Young psychologist" circle [12]. The "Young Psychologist" group is run by Assoc. E. Yoziev. Students of 2-3 courses are involved in the circle, and they are engaged in targeted work in the scientific-research direction.

The team of the department works in cooperation with higher education institutions in the Republic of

Uzbekistan. In particular, he works in constant contact with psychology departments and departments of UzMU, UzDJTU, TDPU named after Nizami, Bukhara State University, and Termiz State University.

So, in the department, taking into account socio-psychological and territorial characteristics, national psychological foundations of professional training, social-psychological foundations of leadership skill formation, psychology of family relations, practical and methodological recommendations are being given to the representatives of this field. In this regard, professors-teachers of the department published a number of methodological manuals and monographs and presented them to a wide readership. The department's relations with state and public organizations (regional internal affairs department, regional public education department, regional court, prosecutor's office, military and other organizations) allow deepening the integration of science, education and production.

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
